

## Headlice

There have been a few cases of headlice in school over the past couple of weeks. Unfortunately this is an ongoing problem in all schools but can be prevented with regular checks and treatment. Please can you check your child's hair and treat if you feel it is necessary. Wet combing is the most reliable way of removing a headlice infestation as it removes the lice and eggs.

## 'Our Door is always open'
