Rubella in school

We sent a text yesterday to say we had an outbreak of Hand, Foot and Mouth in school. This has now been confirmed as a mild case of Rubella. If your child starts developing any of the symptoms, please keep them off school to avoid the virus spreading. It spreads in a similar way to a cold or flu, through droplets of moisture from the nose or throat of someone who's infected. These droplets are released into the air when someone coughs, sneezes or talks. Please be aware that even if your child has received the MMR vaccine, they can still catch a mild form of rubella. Public Health England recommend children should stay off school for 4 days from the onset of the rash.
