### **Friends of Chernobyl's Children Charity Event**

Some of you may be aware that Mrs Outram is involved with the Friends of Chernobyl's Children Charity. The charity brings 10 children aged 7-11 years from Mogilev, Belarus each year for a 1 month stay. The children come from a region in Belarus that is highly contaminated after the Chernobyl Nuclear Disaster. The month that they spend in the UK gives them access to clean air and uncontaminated food which helps to boost their immune systems and prolong their lives.

On Saturday 13th May the charity have an event in the High Street, Northallerton. Various members of the charity will be virtually cycling from Chernobyl to Mogilev, a distance of 360km. Mrs Outram will be cycling at 11.00am outside the town hall. There will also be a cake stall and various people will be around the High Street with collection tins.

Friends of Chernobyl's Children is a very small charity that relies solely on fundraising, donations and the goodwill of local schools/parents to be able to bring the children from Belarus to the UK each year. So if you are in town on Saturday please pop along and support Mrs Outram and the charity. Thank you.
