Byland Class

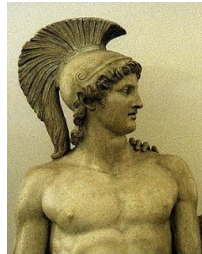
Year 1 and 2 have been learning about the seasons of the year and thinking of what clothing they would wear during different weather conditions.
