

PE Kit

We have noticed over the past few weeks that some children have not had the correct PE kit in school. It would be helpful if your child could bring their kit in every Monday and take it home again on Friday. Our PE kit is as follows:

Reading at home

Reading is an important skill in order for the children to fully access the curriculum. We have noticed recently that some children are not reading at home as regularly as they should be. As part of our home-school agreement, it is essential that you hear your child read at home. We ask that you hear your child read at home every night for a few minutes; this could be at bedtime when sharing a story together, or before their favourite programme on the television, or favourite computer game or over breakfast in the morning. It only takes 5 minutes but it will have an enormous effect on your child's progress. Your support is greatly appreciated.
