## Head Lice

There have been a few cases of headlice in school since returning to school after the summer break. Unfortunately this is an ongoing problem in all schools but can be prevented with regular checks and treatment. Please can you check your child's hair and treat if you feel it is necessary. Wet combing is the most reliable way of removing a headlice infestation as it removes the lice and eggs. Lotions are also useful but children need to be treated twice, normally a few days apart to ensure that any newly hatched lice are eradicated. Thank you for your co-operation with this matter.
