## Picnic in the park

### Sunday 1st July

On Sunday 1st July 2018, (the 102nd anniversary of the Battle of The Somme), and as part of our community commemoration to mark the 100th anniversary of the end of the First World War, Romanby Parish Council is planning and organising two events for all Romanby residents on that day.

The first event on the day is a **formal re-dedication of the Memorial Garden and clock tower**, (some 90 years after it was first unveiled) between 10.30-11.30 am, with representation from the Armed Forces, community and faith groups, and volunteers who have helped with all the restoration work. The event will also include the setting into the ground of a Romanby Parish Time Capsule, containing memorabilia of our time for future generations.

The second part of the day will be a family and friends **Commemoration Picnic in The Park** event at our main leisure park on Ainderby Road from 12-5pm; this will be an opportunity for all Parish families and friends of all ages to gather and enjoy a commemorative but also, we hope, celebratory event, in keeping with the theme of the day. Refreshments will be available, along with live music, bouncy castles, sports events and other fun activities to mark what will be a very special day.
